

Butterfly Metamorphosis

Materials:

- Strips of poster board (I cut a poster board length wise so that I had equal strips)
- Spiral macaroni –for the caterpillar
- Mini shell macaroni – for the eggs
- Regular shell macaroni – for the chrysalis
- Crayons or colored pencils

Divide the poster board strip into fourths. Have students glue some mini shell macaroni in the first square to symbolize the eggs. The next square is the caterpillar represented with a spiral macaroni. Then the regular shell macaroni goes in the third square for the chrysalis. In the last square the student draws a butterfly. Students can create appropriate backgrounds for the other squares as well. Instead of the eggs just being on a white surface, they can color a green leaf, for example.
