

## What is Weather Like in Fall and Winter?

Plan ahead—Provide enough paper square so that children will be able to sort two or more squares into four groups. If you do not have spinners, use the link below to make enough spinners for each group to have spinners.

Have students describe outfits they might wear during spring or summer. Ask *Why is it helpful to know what season is coming next?*

What you need:

- crayons
- construction paper

What to do:

- Take turns spinning the spinner.
- COMMUNICATE: Name a clothing item you might wear in that season. Draw the item you name.
- CLASSIFY: Sort the clothing pictures by season. Label each group.

Think and write

- COMPARE How are all the summer clothes you drew alike?
- What clothes keep you warm in cool weather?

Guided Inquiry

- Solve a Problem: Suppose your cousins are coming to visit you in the winter. What kind of clothes would you tell them to bring?
- Teacher’s note: students need to remember that the types of clothes would depend on the location of the place being visited.
